DISABILITY ACCESS

To Consider

Ruth's introductory paper ...specifically

All YCBA Clubs who wish to participate in the F2F Yorkshire League be required to provide a summary of their club's accessibility arrangements for disabled people as part of the entry process.

- This required information should include as a minimum details about accessibility to the building and playing area(s) as well as details about Accessible Parking and Accessible Toilets.
- The required information, once received by the YCBA, should be collated into a document to enable it to be circulated and/or published on the Yorkshire League page on the YCBA website.
- Consideration should be given to also entering this information onto EBULEague.
- Consideration should be given to asking BridgeWebs to include a section in the "Where & When Information Section" for accessibility arrangements for disabled people.
- All YCBA Clubs (not just those wishing to participate in the F2F Yorkshire League) should be encouraged to publish their accessibility arrangements for disabled people on their club websites.
- Guidance regarding appropriate terminology be circulated to YCBA Clubs to help ensure that club's accessibility arrangements are written using inclusive language. The following weblink provides an example of guidance that could be circulated - <https://gmcdp.com/terminology-and-language>
